

# Our services

**The Harrow Health Care Centre is a long established private General Practice, based at the Clementine Churchill Hospital in Harrow.**

## **Why are we different?**

- + Private GP consultations including personal consultations and medical check-ups
- + Executive health screening and visa, employment and insurance medicals
- + Nurse-led screening including blood tests, vaccinations and wound care
- + Private vaccinations including infant and child immunisation programmes, chicken pox, flu, shingles and HPV vaccines for both male and female patients
- + Women's health clinic specialising in menopause care and cervical screening and HPV testing

  - + Travel Clinic – With nearly 30 years' experience as a travel medicine centre, we offer health advice for overseas travel and a full vaccination service including:
    - Yellow Fever – we are a designated Yellow Fever Vaccination Centre, meaning we are authorised to administer yellow fever vaccine in accordance with International Health Regulations (2005)
    - Hajj/Umrah vaccinations
    - Malaria protection
    - Meningitis ACWY
    - Difficult to obtain vaccinations such as Japanese Encephalitis and Rabies

# How does a Private GP clinic work?

**We believe in complete patient choice – so whether you wish to consult us just once, on an occasional basis or would like to use us as your regular GP on a subscription basis, we are happy to care for your health needs.**

Our GP services are also available:

- + If you are visiting from abroad.
- + If you are not eligible for National Health Service (NHS) care.
- + If you would like a second opinion.

As you would expect, we offer complete confidentiality. You may choose whether you wish us to communicate with your NHS GP – if not, you can be assured that the consultation remains confidential.

Private prescriptions are available and, for your convenience, you can opt for these to be dispensed on-site by the hospital pharmacy or at a pharmacy of your choice.

# How easy is it to book an appointment?

**We understand how important it is to have health concerns dealt with quickly, without delay.**

If you are a registered patient, you will be able to get an appointment to see a GP within 24 hours – for children or for urgent medical matters we can offer same day appointments.

If you are not registered with us, we'll also do our very best to see you within 24 hours although there may be occasions when this is not possible.

Our surgery hours are designed to fit in with your busy schedule, with early morning, evening and weekend appointments available:

**Monday to Thursday:** 8am to 8pm

**Friday:** 8am to 6pm

**Saturday Morning:** 9am to 12 noon

# How long are consultations?

**We offer a range of consultations to suit your individual health needs.**

A 15-minute consultation is suitable if you have a single, minor acute problem such as a sore throat, ear ache or eye infection.

We offer longer 30-minute appointments for other more complex problems, particularly if this is your first visit to us or if you are seeking a second opinion. We can also provide a written report for another doctor if you would like us to.

# What happens if a consultant or hospital referral is needed?

**We can refer you immediately for further diagnostic services or to a consultant of your choice. If appropriate, referrals can be made to either NHS or private hospitals for further investigation or admission.**

We have close working relationships with the consultants within the Clementine Churchill Hospital and other hospitals and can usually recommend a specialist who will be in tune with you and your health needs.
